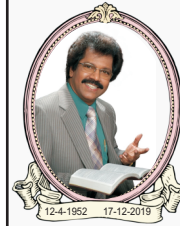
**Good News to All People:**

# The Path That I Trod

My dear Readers,

Loving Greetings!

In the previous issue, I had shared about the marriage of my two younger sisters. But, it was my youngest sister Sylvia's wedding that actually left an even more indelible mark than those of my other sisters. This is because it happened only due to the fervent prayers that my mother and I had prayed and the tears that we had shed at God's presence concerning the marriage. There is a Tamil saying that quotes that marriages are decided upon in Heaven. According to Bible, truly God brings to pass through His Hand, all the things that He has willed. God had preordained the man that Sylvia would marry right in the Hospital where she was born. Are you wondering how? My mother was admitted in the Egmore Maternity Hospital to deliver my sister. At the time, I had just finished my 8th grade in School and had started my 9th Grade. I was the one, who handled the formalities of getting my mother admitted in the Hospital. Since we were three daughters, my father was hoping that this one would be a boy. But, the fourth one also turned out to be a girl baby. My father was so disappointed at this, that he never visited the hospital. I used to come back home from School, prepare food and carry it to the Hospital for my mother. My mother would look at me, feel sorry for me, cry and say "Lord, how much trouble I am giving to my daughter."

When my mother was in the Hospital, the woman in the next bed gave birth to a baby boy. She jokingly told my mother, "Sister, I have just delivered my third boy baby and you have given birth to a fourth girl. And you say that your husband is upset that it is not a boy child. Why don't we exchange our babies?". And just to tease me, my mother told me about the lady's offer and asked me, if we should go ahead with the exchange. Not knowing that she was just playing with me, I became genuinely upset and passionately told my mother that she shouldn't do it and that even, if we end up having ten girls in

the house, we should still keep them all because they are our own flesh and blood. Immediately my mother consoled me by repeating a Tamil saying that loosely translates to 'Even the mother crow considers her chicks to be made out of gold'. She reassured me by saying, she would never part with any of the daughters that God had given her. But the boy, whom they had been joking about at the Hospital on that day, ended up, as my sister Sylvia's groom.

As the children grew, my mother and the boy's mother started working in the same School and became very close friends. Mrs. Rajeswari Jacob reminded my mother Mrs. Jeyaseeli Barnabas of the conversation they had when they were in the labor ward of the Hospital all those years ago and asked her, if she would give Sylvia to her son Reuben as a bride. The Lord decides, who should marry whom and he is able to unite them at His appointed time. Mrs. Rajeswari Jacob Rajarathinam passed away unexpectedly before the two could complete their studies. So, the dream of getting Sylvia and Reuben united came to a halt. However, in a surprising turn of events, one day Reuben's eldest brother Joseph and his wife Chithra, who were living in London came knocking at our door and they asked my mother, if she would give Sylvia in marriage to his youngest brother Reuben, as this had been their mother's wish. My father passed away, when Sylvia was just 2 years old. Already my mother and I had managed to somehow conduct the weddings of my two younger sisters with great difficulty. But, we had never anticipated the third wedding to come with a seemingly improbable requirement. They wanted to conduct the wedding within 10 days, as they wished to travel back to London immediately after.

Just imagine how difficult it is to arrange a wedding within 10 days. The challenges that my mother and I went through were immeasurable. Just as my mother and I did everything together as two women at that time, today my daughter Sheba and I together are running the Miracle Ministry and managing all the responsibilities through fervent prayer, God's grace and your prayer-filled support. The groom's brother and sister-in-law easily asked us to arrange things on such short notice and went

away. The first step that my mother and I took was prayer with the firm belief that our Lord will help us. We didn't have enough money even to print the wedding invitation. With a meager sum of money, we managed to print the invitation in two days and posted them to everyone.

I specially invited many servants of God. My husband was ministering outside India. My husband's close friend Mr. Solomon came to India from the United States of America at that time and was of great help to us. When we pray amidst difficulties God will send someone like an angel. The marriage took place in Adaikalanathar Lutheran Church and the bridegroom's family took care of all preparations at the venue. The reception was arranged in St. Paul's High School Ground. Mr. Arthanary, a teacher working in St. Paul's School did the catering and he graciously offered to take the pay after the wedding. As we were completing one task after the other, a sister in Christ, who was well placed in Bangalore called me and I asked her to attend my sister's marriage. She said she would come and she asked me, if I was in need of help. Since she asked me, I immediately disclosed that we were in financial need. She assured us not to worry and that she would send us Rs. 50,000/- the very next day.

My mother and I were extremely delighted. I told my mother, 'Do not fear, the Lord will perfect everything concerning us and we can easily conduct the wedding'. We slept peacefully that night. The next morning, we promptly received the Cheque, just as she had promised. But, within two hours, she called us back and asked us to return the Cheque immediately. She had taken money from her business to help us. But, since there was an unannounced audit at her firm, she needed the money to be accounted for. She apologized for not being able to help us. I broke out in tears and blurted out the God is good and he has Tamil Proverb that translates, 'We missed out on tasting the delicacy that landed in our hands'. The promise of the Cheque had flown away just as abruptly as it had come. My mother consoled me and said, 'Do not worry Shanthi. God will turn everything for our good and the Lord, who started this, will end it miraculously'. After this, we turned to our family for help. We

hoped to pay back the debt we owed with the money that came, as a gift to the newly weds after the marriage. We prayed with great faith. The wedding took place on 4-11-'92. From the morning there was a heavy downpour and the weatherman predicted that it would continue for the next 48 hours. Early in the morning the next day we all woke up and prayed with tears saying, 'Why Lord this trial? We have no one except you. Father, only you can help us'. At 6-00 AM, I knelt down in the middle of the Road opposite to my house in the heavy rain and cried out with tears, 'Lord, when Elijah, a man just like me prayed, you stopped the rain.

I have arranged the reception in the open space. Father, please stop the rain.' And then I went in. After sometime the rain stopped and there was no rain after that. Since the ground was flooded, we couldn't have the reception in the St. Paul's School Ground. Instead, we had it in a big hall and the reception was conducted beautifully. Since I got drenched in the rain, I couldn't even speak. My heart was pounding because I would have to clear all the debts after the wedding. I was continuously praying in my heart. It was a blessed wedding. Beloved brothers late Evan. Sam Jebadurai and Evan. Arulraj attended the wedding and shared their blessings. After the wedding, everyone had a sumptuous meal and left. Exactly at 10-00 PM the rain started and it continued on for 3 days. Brother Sam Jebadurai asked me, 'Sister, did you pray that the rain should pause only up to 10 PM?'. God is good and he has done marvelous things!

After the wedding, that night my mother's co-sister Mrs. Chandra Barnabas and beloved Bro. Magimaidas opened all the gifts and counted the money. Bro. Magimaidas called me and said, 'Sister, give thanks to the Lord. I believe you will be able to pay back all your debts'. We immediately praised God. The miracle is, to my youngest sister, we could get everything new including the needle and thread, as a gift from the bride's house! I praise God, who made it possible. As you are reading this, I firmly believe that your faith will be kindled and that you can conduct the wedding of your children with God's help.
