Neither I nor my mother Mrs. Jeyaseeli Barnabas had any money in our hands. When we were troubled without knowing what to do, we made a decision. My father had purchased a Plot in Anna Nagar. Not knowing where to turn to for money, we decided to sell the property. Before selling the property, my mother asked my husband, "My dear son, I have no option other than selling the land for arranging my younger daughter's wedding. Why don't you buy this land? I will give it to you for a reduced price." As usual, my husband replied saying, "Aunty, I don't need a house in this world. My mansion is in heaven." And just as he had said, he has now moved into his heavenly home.

Now we are struggling without a house of our own to live in. My mother sold that good property for a paltry sum of Rs. 13,000/- and we managed to conduct my younger sister's wedding. Her husband, Pastor Sridhar used to serve as a Pastor in Dr. Justin Prabhakaran's Church. My husband Dr. John Solomon was the one, who anointed him as Pastor. Now he has established the Alpha and Omega Church and along with his wife, daughter, son-in-law and grand-children they are doing a wonderful ministry.

After this I had to arrange the wedding of my second sister Premi. At least, we had a house to sell off for Rani's wedding. My mother and I prayed together for guidance on what was to be done. In those days, the only property and wealth that my mother and I had was prayer. Through tear-filled prayer we conducted her marriage to Dr. Ashok Kumar. They have two daughters and grand-children. With a lot of struggle, my mother managed to singlehandedly arrange the wedding beautifully with my help.

Whenever my mother went to the money lender's shop to borrow money, she would take me along with her. I can never forget how we used to cry out to the Lord with tears to look down on our situation, whenever we went to borrow money. After borrowing money, my mother used to go through immeasurable struggles to repay the debt. At that time my husband would be ministering out of Town and he would return home only on the day of the wedding or the day before. We never mentioned our troubles to him, because, if my husband had money in his hands, no one could beat him at the game of spending money. My dear brothers and sisters, who have been through or who may be going through similar situations, you will not continue to be indebted like this forever. Your situation will change! The difficult life and the difficult situations that I went through in life are helping me to stand firm in the Ministry. Do not lose heart. The lessons that I learnt in the path that I trod in the past are of great help to me now.

“The Lord who created a way out for Moses, who was drifting down the river - will do a Miracle for you, who have been drowning in tears!”

Will the Lord not do something miraculous for you, who are reading the Miracle Ministry Magazine? Have faith that there is a Miracle that is waiting for you, as you prayerfully read and meditate on this Message.
